The Groveland Police Department is seeking qualified candidates for a **Full-Time Patrol Officer** position. This is a great opportunity to build a career in law enforcement and make a difference in your community. A **one-year probationary period** applies.

Position Summary

Patrol Officers are responsible for enforcing state and local laws within the Town of Groveland. Officers work primarily alone in a radio-equipped vehicle, patrolling assigned areas, responding to incidents, and providing public assistance. This role requires sound judgment, professionalism, and the ability to act decisively in a wide range of situations.

Key Responsibilities

Preventive Patrol

- Patrol designated areas to deter and detect criminal activity.
- Conduct security checks of buildings, public spaces, and schools.
- Investigate suspicious activity, issue traffic citations, and report hazards.

Public Service

- Respond to calls for service and incidents encountered during patrol.
- Provide first aid, assist lost or vulnerable individuals, and refer citizens to appropriate services.
- Maintain peace during public disputes or disturbances.

Report Writing

- Complete detailed reports on crimes, vehicle accidents, and arrests.
- Document witness statements and preserve evidence in accordance with legal standards.
- Submit daily activity summaries and incident explanations as needed.

Miscellaneous Duties

- Serve warrants and court summonses.
- Assist neighboring agencies when authorized.
- Testify in court and coordinate with prosecutors.
- Administer and observe DUI testing procedures as required.

Administrative Tasks

- Maintain proper uniform and equipment standards.
- Stay current on departmental procedures and legal updates.
- Report vehicle maintenance issues and log radio communications appropriately.

Qualifications

- **Required**: Graduation from a full-time in-person Massachusetts Police Training Committee (MPTC) Academy, in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 41, § 96B.
- Preferred: Associate degree or higher in Criminal Justice or a related field.
